Proceedings: ORDER REGARDING ATTORNEYS' FEE AWARD.

The parties have stipulated to an attorneys' fees award. *See* Dkt. 191. In light of that stipulation, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. Defendant USC shall pay Class Counsel's attorneys' fees and costs in the amount of \$20 million, representing attorneys' fees in the amount of \$19,243,762 and litigation expenses in the amount of \$756,238.
2. Class representatives Shannon Lee O'Conner, Vanessa Carlisle, Elizabeth Treadway and Meggie Kwait should be awarded \$20,000 each for service as class representatives in this case, including lending their names to the case, attending court hearings, giving press interviews, and participating in videos explaining the Settlement to Class members. The Court also grants service awards of \$15,000 each to the other 46 class representatives for their contributions to this case, including assisting Class Counsel and detailing their difficult experiences with Tyndall.

Nothing in this order should be construed as a finding regarding the reasonableness of the fee award.
